St. Mary's Mission, Daly Mansion and hiking.

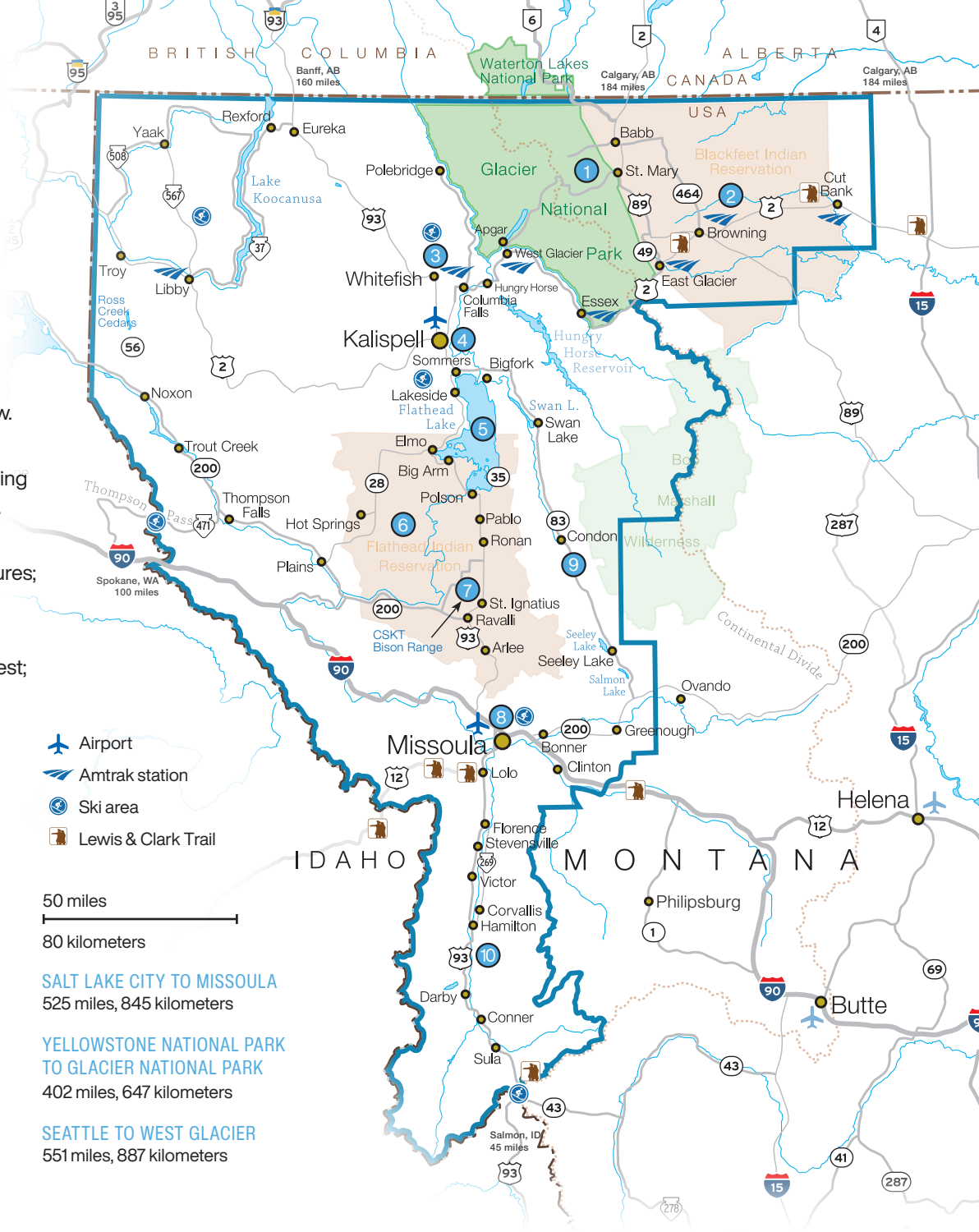

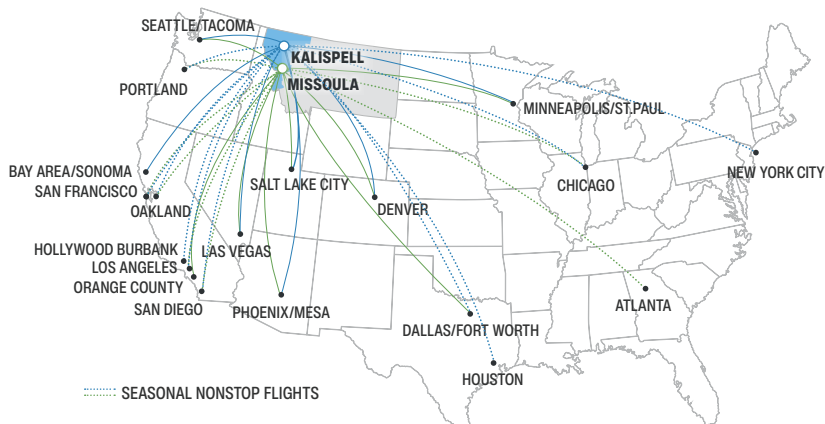
